

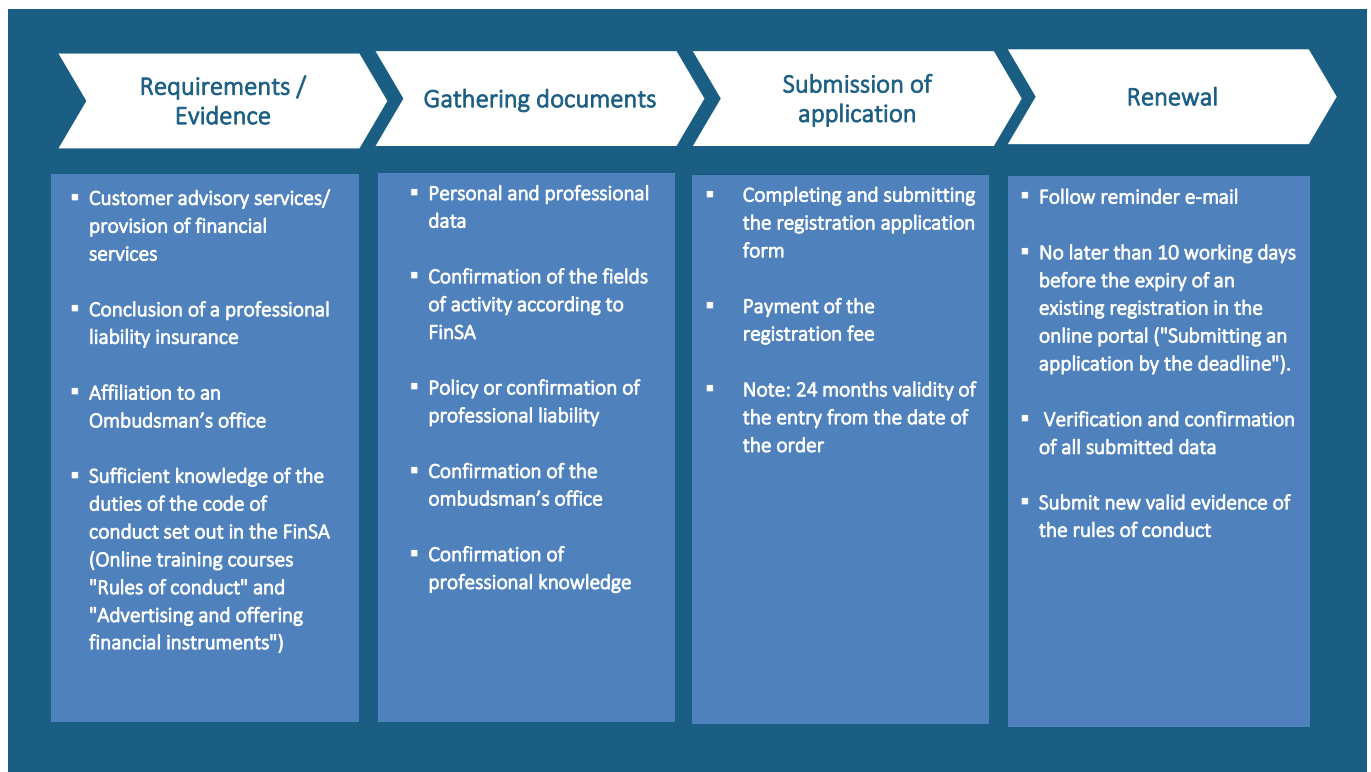
## ENTRY IN THE REGISTER OF ADVISERS

### The current situation

Client advisors of domestic financial service providers that are not supervised within the meaning of Article 3 FINMASA, as well as client advisors of foreign financial service providers that carry out their activities in Switzerland, must be registered in the Register of Advisers pursuant to Article 28 FinSA in order to be able to carry out their activities. In the case of foreign financial service providers, the registration requirement applies to their client advisors, provided the financial service provider belongs to a group supervised by FINMA and they do not provide their financial services in Switzerland only to professional or institutional clients.

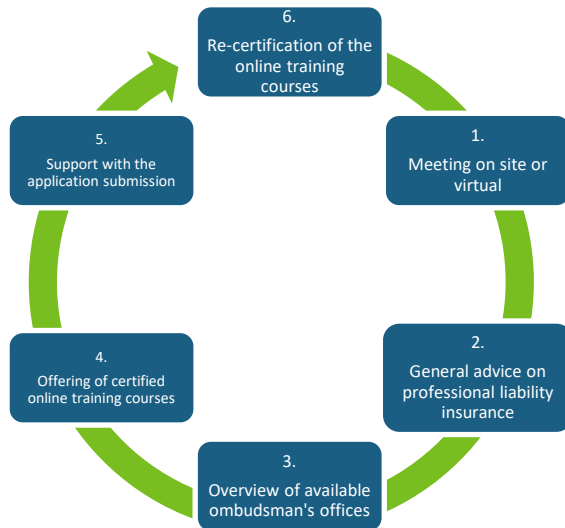
### Implementation – in 4 steps to the entry in the Register of Advisers

The entry into the Register of Advisers requires the submission of various documents. In a first step, these requirements and evidences are collected. These include, for example, confirmation of a professional liability insurance and an Ombudsman's office, as well as proof of sufficient knowledge of the duties of conduct under FinSA. The next step is to complete and submit the registration application. Around 24 months later, the renewal application is due, for which SwissComply provides support.
